

## **RANCHO MIRAGE TO OFFER FREE COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) TRAINING**

**June 27-29, 2014 (Friday 5:30 to 9:30 p.m.; Saturday & Sunday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)**

To help prepare citizens to care for themselves, their families, and neighbors in the event of a major disaster, the City of Rancho Mirage is offering a free Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, June 27th, 28th, and 29th. The class begins at 5:30 p.m. on Friday and goes until 9:30 p.m. Training on Saturday and Sunday will run from 8 a.m. until approximately 5:00 p.m. Training consists of classroom and hands-on exercises.

The CERT Training will be conducted at the Roy Wilson Training Center in Thousand Palms. The Center is located on the north side of Ramon Road, approximately ½ mile east of Interstate 10 Freeway, between the fire station and the Thousand Palms United States Post Office.

This CERT training is funded through a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security. The training is conducted by Riverside County Office of Emergency Services and administered by the City of Rancho Mirage.

Although the training and materials are given to the students at no cost, registration is required to ensure a space in the class. [Click here](#) to download a registration form.
