

Training consists of classroom and hands-on exercises. The CERT Training will be conducted at the Roy Wilson Training Center in Thousand Palms. The Center is located on the north side of Ramon Road, approximately 1/2 mile east of Interstate 10 Freeway, between the fire station and the Thousand Palms United States Post Office. This form is an application only not a confirmation that you are in the class. After processing by City staff, you will be notified if you have been successfully enrolled in the class. **There is no charge to take this class but students must complete all 3 days of the class to receive a CERT certificate of completion.** Students should wear appropriate clothing including closed-toe shoes for being outdoors as part of the training and be able to do physical activities such as stooping, standing, kneeling and light lifting. Training will be conducted by the City of Rancho Mirage Fire Department.
