



**NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS FOR
BOB HOPE DRIVE AND FRANK SINATRA DRIVE
INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
PROJECT NO. CP 12-270-1**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Rancho Mirage, hereinafter referred to as CITY, invites sealed bids for the above-stated project and will receive such bids in the offices of the City Engineer up to the hour of **2:00 P.M., on Tuesday, April 26, 2016**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents for the above-stated project. The general items of work to be done consist of removal of existing improvements including curb and gutter, asphalt, aggregate base, storm drain pipe, and landscaping, and then construction of curb and gutter, aggregate base, placement of asphalt concrete, tire rubber modified asphalt concrete, catch basin, curb inlet and depression, access ramps, storm drain modification, removal and reconstruction of block wall, construction of retaining wall, sidewalk, traffic signal modification, and traffic striping, markers and markings, irrigation, landscaping, as well as all other appurtenant related work.

Plans and Specifications are available only through the City’s website at: www.RanchoMirageCA.gov. If you are interested in this project, you will need to visit the City’s website and sign up. To receive plans you must complete the on-line registration form. Once you have signed up you will receive an email with the requested documents for download and printing.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Department of Industrial Relations will be required.

No bidders will be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion in any consideration leading to the award of contract.

The contract documents call for monthly progress payments based upon the engineers’ estimate of the percentage of work completed. The CITY will retain 5 percent of each progress payment as security for completion of the balance of the work. At the request and expense of the successful bidder, the City will pay the amounts so retained upon compliance with the requirements of Public Contract Code, Part 5, Section 22300 and the provisions of the contract documents pertaining to Substitution of Securities.

Bids must be prepared on the approved proposal forms in conformance with the Instructions to Bidders and submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside **“SEALED BID FOR BOB HOPE DRIVE AND FRANK SINATRA DRIVE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CP 12-270-1 – DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL.”** City staff will not be available to respond to questions on the day of bid opening.

The CITY reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, to accept any bid or portion thereof, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of sixty (60) days.

At the time of contract award, the prime contractor shall possess a valid **Class A contractor’s license and/or a combination of Class “C” specialty contractors license(s) sufficient to perform the work.**
