



**NOTICE INVITING INFORMAL BIDS  
FOR  
INSTALLATION OF STEEL SECURITY FENCING AT  
RANCHO MIRAGE COMMUNITY PARK PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Rancho Mirage, hereinafter referred to as City, invites informal bids for the above-stated project and will receive such bids in the offices of the Public Works Director up to the hour of **4:00 P.M. on TUESDAY, the 12th day of JULY, 2016.**

**1. PROJECT:** Installation of Steel Security Fencing at Rancho Mirage Community Park Project CP 16-323

**2. DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF WORK**

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents for the above-stated project. The general items of work to be done hereunder consist of the fabrication and installation of an architecturally exposed structural-steel fence enclosure and entry gates to secure the Rancho Mirage Community Park Amphitheater. Improvements include, but are not limited to, site preparation, footing excavation, fence footings and attachments, fence panels, and gates.

Demolition, removal and/or relocation of plant material, boulders, irrigation systems and equipment, and other surface and sub-surface items that will conflict with the installation of the fence enclosure shall be the responsibility of the City. Items that are discovered by the successful bidder during the course of construction that conflict with the installation of the fence enclosure shall be brought to the attention of the City immediately and shall be addressed by the City's forces unless directed otherwise. Items moved, damaged, or destroyed by the successful bidder during the course of construction shall become the responsibility of the successful bidder and shall be replaced or restored to working order and condition to the satisfaction of the City.

Restoration and/or replacement of plant material, boulders, irrigation systems and equipment, and other surface and sub-surface items displaced by this project shall be restored upon completion of the fence enclosure and shall be the responsibility of the City.

**3. REQUIRED LICENSE:** Type Class (A) General Engineering Contractor and/or a combination of Class (C) specialty licenses.

**Required License Type:** At the time of contract award, the prime contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license and/or a combination of Class C specialty contractor's license(s) sufficient to perform the work. The successful bidder must possess a valid contractor's license throughout the duration of the Contract. The Contractor's California State License number shall be clearly stated on the bidder's proposal.

**4. DURATION OF WORK:** 60 Calendar Days

## 6. BIDDING DOCUMENTS

Once you have signed up you will receive an email with the requested documents for download and printing.

## 7. BID SUBMISSION

Sealed Bids will be accepted until **4:00 P.M. on TUESDAY, the 12th day of JULY, 2016**.

## 8. PREVAILING WAGE LAWS

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Department of Industrial Relations will be required.

## 9. BIDDER'S SECURITY

Each bidder's bid must be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security: (1) cash; (2) a cashier's check made payable to the City; (3) a certified check made payable to the City; or (4) a bidder's bond executed by a California admitted surety as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, made payable to the City in the form set forth in the Contract Documents.

Such bidder's security must be in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the maximum amount of bid as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed Contract. If Bidder is awarded contract, such bidder will provide the required Performance and Payment Bonds, insurance certificates and any other required documents. In the event of failure to enter into said Contract or provide the necessary documents, said security will be forfeited.

## 10. RETENTION

The CITY will retain 5 percent of each progress payment as security for completion of the balance of the work. At the request and expense of the successful bidder, the City will pay the amounts so retained upon compliance with the requirements of Public Contract Code, Part 5, Section 22300 and the provisions of the contract documents pertaining to Substitution of Securities.

## 11. SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES

In conformance with the State of California Public Contract Code, Part 5, Section 22300, CONTRACTOR may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the CITY to ensure performance under this Agreement.

## **12. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**

Separate payment and performance bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the total Contract amount, are required, as set forth in the Contract Documents. To be acceptable, surety companies must be authorized to do business and have an agent for service of process in California, be on the accredited list of the United States Treasury Department, and have an "A" policyholder's rating and a financial rating of Class V, or better, in accordance with the current Best's Rating.

## **13. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS**

The CITY reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, to accept any bid or portion thereof, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of sixty (60) days.

No bidders will be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion in any consideration leading to the award of contract.
