



**NOTICE INVITING INFORMAL BIDS
FOR
TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND SAFETY LIGHT PAINTING
Project No. CP 16-325**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Rancho Mirage, hereinafter referred to as City, invites informal bids for the above-stated project and will receive such bids in the offices of the Public Works Director up to the hour of **4:00 P.M. on TUESDAY, the 26TH day of JULY, 2016.**

1. PROJECT: Traffic Signal and Safety Light Painting CP 16-325

2. DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF WORK

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the Specifications and Contract Documents for the above-stated project. **The general items of work to be done hereunder consist of surface preparation and painting of various traffic signals and safety lighting poles and signal gear in the City of Rancho Mirage. Work includes all signal standards, bases, mast arms, luminaire heads, luminaire mast arms, pedestrian signal heads, pedestrian push buttons, back of signal heads, back plate of signal heads, inside and outside of visors, illuminated street name sign framework, all mounting hardware, and electrical service pedestals.**

3. REQUIRED LICENSE: Type Class A and/or a combination of Class (C) specialty licenses.

Required License Type: At the time of contract award, the prime contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license and/or a combination of Class C specialty contractor's license(s) sufficient to perform the work. The successful bidder must possess a valid contractor's license throughout the duration of the Contract. The Contractor's California State License number shall be clearly stated on the bidder's proposal.

6. BIDDING DOCUMENTS

Contract Documents, Drawings and Plans are available through the City's website at: www.RanchoMirageCA.gov. If you are interested in this project, you will need to visit the City's website and sign up. To receive plans you must complete the on-line registration form. Once you have signed up you will receive an email with the requested documents for download and printing.

7. BID SUBMISSION

Sealed Bids will be accepted until **4:00 P.M. on TUESDAY, the 26th day of JULY, 2016**.

8. PREVAILING WAGE LAWS

Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages and apprenticeship employment standards established by the State Department of Industrial Relations will be required.

9. BIDDER'S SECURITY

Each bidder's bid must be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security: (1) cash; (2) a cashier's check made payable to the City; (3) a certified check made payable to the City; or (4) a bidder's bond executed by a California admitted surety as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, made payable to the City in the form set forth in the Contract Documents.

Such bidder's security must be in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the maximum amount of bid as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed Contract. If Bidder is awarded contract, such bidder will provide the required Performance and Payment Bonds, insurance certificates and any other required documents. In the event of failure to enter into said Contract or provide the necessary documents, said security will be forfeited.

10. RETENTION

The CITY will retain 5 percent of each progress payment as security for completion of the balance of the work. At the request and expense of the successful bidder, the City will pay the amounts so retained upon compliance with the requirements of Public Contract Code, Part 5, Section 22300 and the provisions of the contract documents pertaining to Substitution of Securities.

11. SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES

In conformance with the State of California Public Contract Code, Part 5, Section 22300, CONTRACTOR may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the CITY to ensure performance under this Agreement.

12. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND

Separate payment and performance bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the total Contract amount, are required, as set forth in the Contract Documents. To be acceptable, surety companies must be authorized to do business and have an agent for service of process in California, be on the accredited list of the United States Treasury Department, and have an "A" policyholder's rating and a financial rating of Class V, or better, in accordance with the current Best's Rating.

13. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

The CITY reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, to accept any bid or portion thereof, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of sixty (60) days.

No bidders will be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion in any consideration leading to the award of contract.
